Sendflex is a parcel transportation management system (TMS) designed to help shippers address the complexities that have arisen in the fast-paced world of eCommerce. Sendflex provides logistics managers with more control over how, when, and where to use diversified carrier services within omni-channel fulfillment networks.

# Sendflex Automates Carrier Service Selections and Account Billing Decisions in the US and Canada

Sendflex implemented a process where Chef Works personnel scan bar codes affixed to cartons. Sendflex accesses order data from AWL. Multi-carton orders are monitored to assign appropriate carton counts.

In the Poway, California distribution center, Sendflex applies business rules that determine which carrier services to use among FedEx, UPS, USPS and DHL. In the Ontario, Canada distribution center, a different set of rules are applied to UPS, FedEx, Purolator, and CanadaPost services. Sendflex calculates shipping charges for the optimized carrier service and books the shipment, printing the appropriate carrier label for the carton, including multiple carton orders (1 or 3, 2 of 3, etc.) when indicated. Minimal operator intervention is required.

Sendflex also prints customs compliant documentation for international shipments, including commercial invoices and Shipper's Export Declarations.

Sendflex then updates AWL with shipping charges and tracking information. Sendflex applies rules for how shipping charges should be billed and to what accounts based on ship via, destination and origin factors.
